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## “Hands on History” Field Trip

It's surprising how many children who live within proximity of the temples have not visited them and are not yet aware of the richness of their culture and heritage. Not only that, many rural children have not been to the city of Siem Reap. You will accompany 20 primary school students and their teacher along with one licensed tour guide (giving the tour in khmer) to Angkor Wat and Angkor Thom with a lunch stop in Siem Reap City. ### Logistics

- We will pick you up from your hotel around 6.30 am to go pick the students up from school
- On to the temples for the “Hands on History” experience
- After the temples, walking the Old Market area of Siem Reap to acquaint the students with the city
- Big lunch at Khmer Kitchen (On Pub Street) at 11am
- Visit Lucky Mall so students can see amazing things like sliding glass doors & escalators
- At the mall, the children get to go up to the bookstore and choose one book to take home and then buy an icecream
- You'll finish around 3 or 4 pm unless you wish to accompany the students back to school, then it will be more like 5pm finish
